

Code of Conduct for Junior Players

When I play netball, I will:

- *Always play to my best ability
- *Play fairly, I won't cheat, complain or waste time
- *Respect my team mates, my coaches, umpires and other teams
- *Play by the rules as directed by the umpire, with no arguing
- *Listen and respond to what my coaches tell me
- *Shake hands with other team mates or teams at the end of a match
- *Talk to someone I trust, or the club welfare officer, if I'm unhappy about anything at my club

I understand that if I do **not** follow the code, any/all of the following actions may be taken by the club

- *Apologise to my team mates, other team, coach or umpire
- *Receive a formal warning from the coach
- *Be suspended from training
- *Be required to leave the club

- *Ensure my child wears appropriate clothing for sport and weather conditions ie: layers, gloves, hat for winter and sun cream for summer
- *Ensure my child brings a drink to each training session
- *Ensure my child arrives on time to start the session at 9.00am promptly
- *Ensure my child is either collected on time at the end of the session or knows that he/she is making own way home. The child is then the responsibility of the parent/carer
- *Encourage my child and support the efforts and performance given, through motivating comments.
- *Remember that children learn best by example so I will applaud good play by both my child's team and opponents
- *Respect the coaches and umpires decisions and time volunteering
